

Criteria for Nominee to the Nominating Committee

The Nominating Committee is responsible for selecting accomplished individuals to serve in key leadership positions within the Board of Directors and future nominating committees.

- 1. Must be a Regular* IAFN Member in good standing.
- 2. Must be willing to serve the required 3-year term of the elected office.
- 3. Must be able to attend committee meetings via conference call.
- 4. Must demonstrate leadership skills.
- 5. Preference will be given to candidates who have been involved in the Association or other nursing organizations.

^{*} Regular Member: A person who has been formally accepted for membership and is engaged in forensic nursing practice, who is a registered nurse in good standing with the licensing boards in the jurisdiction of practice, and whose professional orientation is toward forensic nursing. Regular members may vote and hold office in the organization.
