Stephen Goux is a psychiatric mental health nurse specializing in forensic nursing. He holds both the SANE-A and SANE-P certifications through the International Association of Forensic Nurses and is a Board Certified Advanced Forensic Nurse through the American Nurses Credentialing Center. Mr. Goux holds a baccalaureate degree in nursing, a Master of Science in Nursing, and a Master of Science in Forensic DNA and Serology. He is a current doctoral student in a Ph.D. program focusing on research related to the advancement of nursing education. He is also pursuing his Nurse Practitioner in Psychiatric/Mental Health. He has served as a clinical resource and consultant to numerous organizations and governmental entities. He is a former law enforcement officer, having served in many different areas, including communications, patrol, investigations, negotiations, and corrections. Mr. Goux currently serves on the Professional Development Council at his current institution and is a published author and national speaker on various pediatric and forensic nursing topics. His teaching roles have included adjunct faculty, clinical faculty, and preceptor faculty for newly trained SANEs.
